The Senior Community Service Employment Program/Senior AIDE Participants serve their communities while gaining valuable on-the-job training through paid temporary assignments with local non-profit and government organizations including: schools, libraries, social service agencies, senior centers and museums.

The Senior Community Service Employment Program helps older workers build the experience and confidence they need to find permanent employment.

Enrollee's, over 55 years of age, within certain income guidelines are trained or retrained for today's workforce. Our goal is to build and develop senior' skills and confidence leading to permanent employment.

Participants receive 20 hours per week of paid work experience for the services they provide the host agency.

In exchange for the participant's services of the host agency, the host agency provides a supportive environment, supervision and the use of new workplace technology. This environment supports the critical training component.

The recruiting, training and placement of older workers in countless assignments demonstrates their ability, reliability, dependability and enthusiasm to enter or return to the workforce.
