

SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

Our agency will be having a summer employment program for youth this year. The program runs from 6/1/10 thru 8/31/10 which means the child can be employed anytime during those three (3) months of the year.

Eligible youth are:

1. Youth ages 16-17, as long as the youth is a minor child in a needy family and is in school (youth may be 18 if they are a full time student in a secondary school);
2. Youth ages 18 - 24, as long as they are in a needy family that also has a minor child; or
3. Youth ages 18-24 that have a minor child and are considered needy
4. Family income guides that have eligible youth (meet the above definitions) assistance group income have to be under 200% federal poverty level

Poverty level guidelines **(example)**

- 1 person AG - \$0 - \$1,805
- 2 person AG - \$1,806 - \$2,429
- 3 person AG - \$2,430 - \$3,052
- 4 person AG - \$3,053 - \$3,675
- 5 person AG - \$3,676 - \$4,299
- 6 person AG - \$4,300 - \$4,922

The agency will pay employers for wages (at no higher than state minimum wage) and fringe benefits (excluding health benefits). This includes worker compensation expenses and FICA.
